Gospel & Gumbo is a biennial fundraiser that benefits the Michael E. Green Prescription Fund for St. Joseph Medical Clinic. In its 14-year existence, the fund has provided over \$450,000 for prescription drugs and laboratory costs.

Enjoy familiar gospel hymns sung by the St. Joseph Catholic Church Choir. Plus, Infusion jazz band will be adding their own blend of sounds to the Gospel & Gumbo pot, and Sheriff David Morgan will entertain guests with his singing.

Finally, East Hill Pharmacy has developed a collaborative relationship with the clinic physicians since it was first established. This relationship has allowed the clinic to provide prescription services at a substantial savings. These savings have benefitted both the clinic and its patients to better aid in their medication needs.

The cost of the event is \$100 per person, payable to Our Lady of Angels. \$1,000 sponsorships are also encouraged and offer an opportunity to invite 10 friends or employees to join you at the event.

OUR LADY OF ANGELS ST. JOSEPH MEDICAL CLINIC



St. Joseph Medical Clinic was established in 2002 by a small group of physicians and parishioners, led by Dr. David Conkle, founder and current medical director. Its mission is to provide medical and dental services for uninsured, low-income patients in our community in an atmosphere where dignity is restored to the ill.

St. Joseph's Medical Clinic is located on the site of the former Our Lady of Angels Maternity Hospital for African American women.

Father Joseph J. Raleigh established the maternity hospital in 1946 next to the convent when he realized there was not a public hospital within 75 miles of Pensacola that would accept African-American maternity cases, forcing black and creole women to have their babies at home. An order of Franciscan nuns from Pennsylvania administered Our Lady of Angels Hospital for more than two decades until local hospitals were integrated in the mid 1960s.

Today, St. Joseph's Medical Clinic is staffed entirely by a volunteer group of doctors, dentists, nurses, social workers and administrative personnel. The clinic has 82 volunteer providers who work tirelessly to assist the working poor, the uninsured and the homeless in Escambia County.

The clinic's financial support comes from St. Joseph Catholic Church, community grants and from charitable donations by the community. The clinic's primary expense is the cost of prescription drugs.
